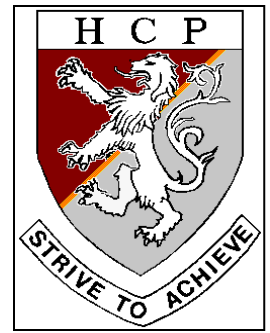

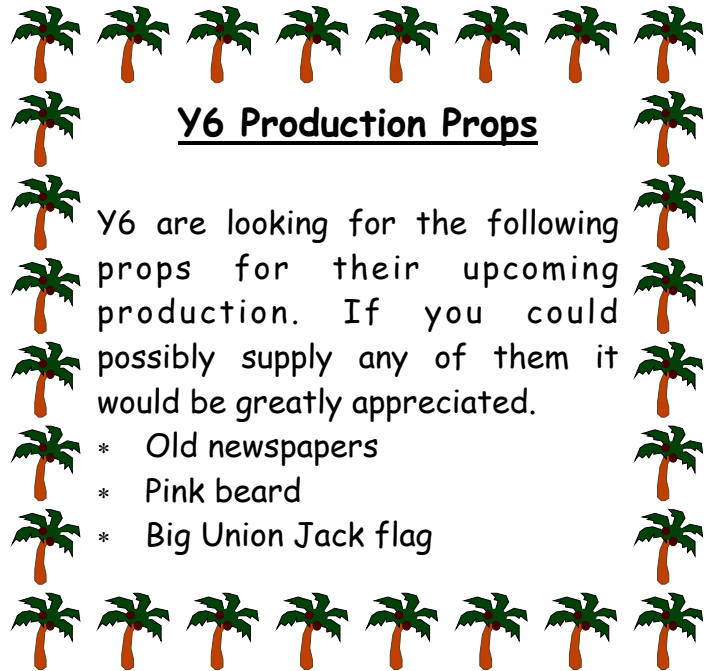
Gymnastics

Measles Flyer

Please find attached the flyer from our school nurse. It addresses common questions about measles and the measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) vaccine that protects against the disease.

The flyer refers to recent outbreaks and explains why everyone eligible requires two doses of MMR vaccine to protect them from measles.

Please Note...
